

Regulations for online submission of applications for taking admission in U.G. Courses at Kharagpur College in the academic session 2021-2022

Key Terms and their Definitions (wherever necessary):

1. Eligibility
2. Aggregate
3. Subject or Related Subject in HS Examination
4. Merit Point
5. Approved Council/Board conducting Higher Secondary/Equivalent, henceforth called HS, Examination.
6. Migrating/Non-migrating and Other Board Students.
7. Subject Combination.

1. Eligibility:

- (i) Students must have passed HS examination with minimum 45% marks in the aggregate or 50% marks in the Subject or Related Subject to apply for admission in Honours Course except English (Hons.). **To apply for English (Hons.), students must obtain 50% marks in English in HS examination.** To apply for BCA (Hons), candidates must pass with 45% marks in Mathematics/Computer science/Computer application
- (ii) In addition to clause (i), any student seeking admission with Economics (Hons.) or Accountancy (Hons.) must have obtained 45% marks in Mathematics in Secondary/Madhyamik examination or passed Mathematics at HS examination.
- (iii) Students seeking admission in **Physics (Hons.) and Chemistry (Hons.)** must have obtained 60% marks in **Mathematics** in HS examination.
- (iv) Students must obtain pass marks in **at least five** subjects to apply for both Honours and General Courses.
- (v) Students passing HS examination in 2021, 2020 & 2019 can only submit their application forms online.

2. Aggregate:

- (i) Marks obtained in Best 5 out of 6 Subjects = Aggregate
- (ii) For students having single Language which must be English at HS examination
Marks obtained in Language + 4 Subjects = Aggregate.
Aggregate marks obtained by the students must be out of Full Marks 500.

4. **Merit Point:**

(i) For Applicants in Honours Subjects

Merit Point = 10% of Aggregate + Subject or Highest among the Related Subjects.

(ii) For Applicants in General Stream

Merit Point = Aggregate. .

5. **Approved Council/Board** conducting Higher Secondary/Equivalent, henceforth called HS, Examination.

6. **Migrating/Non-migrating and Other Board Students:**

Students Passing from the following Boards/Councils are called Non-migrating students:

(i) West Bengal Council for Higher Secondary Education (WBCHSE),

(ii) Rabindra Mukto Vidyalaya, West Bengal,

(iii) West Bengal Board of Madrasah Examination,

(iv) West Bengal State Council of Vocational Education & Training, Kolkata.

Students passing from any approved Boards/Councils except West Bengal Council for Higher Secondary Education (WBCHSE) are called Other Board students.
